
We are very fortunate to have someone of the calibre of Brent working on this system for this for the Club.

## LUCKY MEMBER DRAW




The Lucky member draw commencement date will be announced shortly. We are working on an accurate member data base as quickly as possible to allow this club promotional event to commence thank you for your patience.



## FATHERS DAY at The BOWL and FORK


